ELIGIBILITY

Any Passenger who is a Crawford County resident and is age 60+ or a disabled adult.

HOW IT WORKS:

The "Find Your Own Driver" Program (FYOD) allows the Passenger to select their Driver for transportation to a destination and return. The Passenger is reimbursed the miles traveled through the FYOD program. In turn, the Passenger then pays the driver.

FYOD

Find Your Own Driver

Program that allows the Passenger to select their Driver for transportation to a destination and receive reimbursement.

STEPS INVOLVED TO BE PART OF FYOD:

- Residents call in to the Crawford County
 ADRC requesting a trip.
- The FYOD Coordinator determines if the Passenger is a candidate. If so, an application is completed and the Passenger is required to sign an agreement.
- If approved the FYOD Coordinator informs the Passenger in writing.
- No Cost is Incurred by the Passenger
- The Passenger submits mileage information to the FYOD Coordinator via mail once a month before the <u>8th of the</u> <u>following month</u> of ridership.
- The FYOD Coordinator reviews the request and once approved forwards the reimbursement checks via mail to the Passenger by the <u>30th of each month</u>.



REIMBURSEMENT RATE:

The reimbursement rate is \$.40 per mile traveled. This is subject to change depending on funding.

The maximum miles to be reimbursed to a Passenger per month is 500 miles.

DRIVER ELIGIBILITY:

Anyone who has a valid driver's license.

TYPES OF TRIPS THAT ARE REIMBURSED:

All trips which require medical attention, including medical, dental, vision, prescription drugs, hear, speech or physical therapy, and medical treatments such as dialysis.

Future expansions of this program to other trips will depend on funding.
