- Punch cards must be purchased through the Aging & Disability Resource Center.
- You cannot purchase punch cards from your taxi driver.
- Please contact the taxi company directly to arrange for a ride and to determine additional charges if your trip is outside the city limits.

Get Out and Go!

Are there any limitations?

The ADRC has an allotted number of punch cards to sell each month. Clients may purchase one (1) punch card per month. A second card may be issued for special circumstances only with **documented proof of need**.

How do I pay the taxi company?

Just show the taxi driver your punch card.

Note: When you call for a pick-up, please let the dispatcher know you will be paying with a punch card and inquire about additional charges if your trip is outside of the city.

What is it?

The Taxi Subsidy Program provides discounted punch cards for your local taxi service. The program is made possible by the ADRC's 85.21 Grant with a Crawford County tax levy match.

Who can use it?

Crawford County residents age 60 and older and adults with disabilities.

Benefits:

- Transportation when you need it
- 7 days a week
- Evenings and weekends
- No long waits
- Creates independence and more opportunities for socialization

How can I get into the program?

What happens after I apply?

Once your application and payment is received and approved, you will be mailed your taxi voucher punch card and a re-order form. Be sure to include your return address on your application.

How many punch cards can I buy?

A maximum of one punch card per month per customer. Punch cards can be carried over from month to month. A participant may use more than one punch card per month if they have punches left over from a previous purchase.
