## CRAWFORD COUNTY TRANSPORTATION

CCT is a program made available by the ADRC's 85:21 Grant with a Crawford County tax levy match. CCT offers reduced fare transportation to those 60 or better and persons with disabilities on one of our six vehicles.

All CCT vehicles are wheel chair accessible and we serve all parts of Crawford County.

All passengers are picked up and dropped off at their homes unless otherwise requested.

### ELIGIBILITY

Any person 60 years of age or older or persons with disabilities living in Crawford County are eligible to use CCT. In addition to those 60 and better and persons with disabilities, if space permits, any adult who needs transportation to area businesses may also be served.

### PRIORITY & NON-PRIORITY TRIPS

State law allows Crawford County to give priority to certain types of trips. A "priority trip" is a trip that is taken for nutrition & medical reasons. A "non-priority trip" is a trip taken for shopping or personal business.



### TRIP RESERVATIONS

Each vehicle is filled on a "first come, first serve" basis. Please call at least 48 hours in advance to place your reservation. For last minute notification, you must call us no later than Noon on the business day prior to the day of your trip. For trips on Monday, you must call before Noon on Friday.

When you call, we will ask you the date and time of your appointment and how long your appointment will last. Be sure to notify the scheduler of any special needs or if assistance is needed for your trip.
